


# Map of the Ammassalik Area


The Ammassalik area in East Greenland offers captivating panoramas of snow-capped peaks, endless blue waterways, deep fjords with colossal floating icebergs and vast terrains of steep mountains reaching straight down into the sea.

**Greenland ice sheet**  
 Roughly 80% of the island of Greenland is covered by the ice sheet and the Ammassalik region is located at the foothills of the ice sheet in East Greenland.  
 It is 3km at its thickest point and contains about 3 million cubic kilometers of ice



**Polar Bears**  
 They travel with the sea ice along the east coast of Greenland, observing them in their natural habitat ranks as one of East Greenland's most unparalleled experiences
